Request for Expression of Interest (REOI)
For

“Consultancy Services for Standardizing Coal Loss of Payra 1320 MW TPP based on its entire Coal Supply Chain”

1. BCPCL has been importing coal from Indonesia since 2019 to run the power plant. Now, BCPCL intends to appoint an international consultancy firm to set typical standard coal loss threshold for Payra 1320 MW TPP and to suggest mechanisms to reduce coal loss within the standard limits. The cost of the said services will be borne by BCPCL.
2. The objective of the consulting services (“the Services”) mainly include:
 - i. Complete audit of the coal supply chain in order to identify the potential causes of coal losses and estimate the quantity of losses for identified causes.
 - ii. A comprehensive report documenting the findings, methodology and recommendations from the audit.
3. The Consultancy service for all the activities are expected to commence from the date of signing of Contract. Duration of the Contract will be 6 months.
4. BCPCL now invites eligible consultancy firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. The Consultancy Firm should have at least relevant experience in the below mentioned points:
 - i. The firm shall have at least ten (10) years of consulting experience in bulk material logistics, loss assessment, and performance benchmarking.
 - ii. The firm shall have at least one (1) successfully completed project experience of coal loss standardization for coal-supply chain logistics handling a minimum of 2 million tons of coal. Experience related to coal-fired power plants shall be given priority.
 - iii. The firm must have origin from eligible source of country (All countries except Israel).
 - iv. The firm shall have a minimum liquid asset amounting USD 50,000 (fifty thousand) only or equivalent in other currencies.
 - v. The firm shall have a minimum average annual turnover amounting USD 100,000 (one hundred thousand) only or equivalent in other currencies in last 3 years.

5. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint-venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
6. A firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality Cost Based Selection (QCBS), International Method.
